Report in Brief

Following the directive from the Department of Higher Education, Govt of Nagaland to mentor non-accredited colleges, a mentoring programme was jointly conducted for the mentee colleges with Kohima College, Kohima. All the mentee colleges attended the programme. They were: Baptist College, Kohima, Capital College of Higher Education, Kohima, College of Arts and Technology, Nerhe Phezha, Don Bosco College, Kohima, Peren Govt College, Peren & St Xavier College, Jalukie. This is the fourth such programme conducted by the college.

The programme was chaired by Mrs Sungjeminla, Assistant Coordinator, IQAC, KCK. She highlighted the main objective of NAAC which was to assess and accredit higher education institutions to generate quality in education by encouraging a proactive quality culture.

Dr Seyiekhrielie Whiso, Coordinator, IQAC, Kohima Science College, Jotsoma gave a presentation on the seven criteria, the Key Indicators (KIs) in the Quality Indicator Framework (QIF), and the Qualitative Metrics (Q_1M) and Quantitative Metrics (Q_nM). He highlighted all the important indicators while also sharing the experiences of the college and helpful tips.

Mrs Jarani Mao, Coordinator, IQAC, Don Bosco College, College gave a talk on the process of assessment highlighting their experience of preparation, submission of IIQA, SSR and the onsite Peer Team visit. This was a very helpful presentation.

This was followed by an informal Q&A session where many questions were fielded and views exchanged.

Dr (Mrs) Konei Nakhro, Asst Coordinator, IQAC, KCK proposed the vote of thanks.

After lunch, the participants visited the various facilities of the college.

In all thirty one (31) IQAC members from eight (8) colleges participated in the programme.

Present Status of the Mentee Colleges

- 1. Don Bosco College, Kohima already had its Peer Team visit during the last week of March, 2021. Their accreditation result is expected any day.
- 2. Baptist College, Kohima and St Xavier College, Jalukie will be submitting their IIQA sometime later in the year.
- 3. All the colleges are enthusiastic about the NAAC assessment and are accordingly working towards this end. They will be conducting internal consultancy programme in their respective colleges. They have also sounded their interest in conducting dry-run/mock visit in their respective colleges.
- 4. Except for DBCK, the other colleges are yet to do their *Academic and Administrative Audit* (AAA) This exercise will greatly benefit them.
