The Intervention: The Vice-principal and the IQAC study the students' feedback which is submitted in a sealed envelope. The documents are analyzed and the vice-principal personally meets any teacher who gets any adverse remarks. The interventions are directive but more like a 'holding up of a mirror' to the teacher and department.

The Analysis along with the scores are then sent to the respective department so that it can be use the assessment results to understand and act and maximize the effectiveness of teaching and its related activities.
