## SSS Analysis

Using the Student Satisfaction Survey questionnaire designed by NAAC, we administered it to our $2^{\text {nd }}$, $4^{\text {th }}, \& 6^{\text {th }}$ Semester BA, BSc, and BVoc students, and also $2^{\text {nd }} \& 4^{\text {th }}$ Semester MSc students.

A brief analysis is given below
Objective: This multivariate estimate of the various areas mentioned above is to generate some useful feedbacks to teaching and learning. It is to strengthen quality teaching-learning environment and to look for opportunities to improve teachers' performance in classroom and laboratory engagements.

Response to each question is represented by a pie chart and each colored slice represents specific percentage distribution relative to the whole.

1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?
. (Students are aware that 'class' also includes their virtual/online classroom.)
